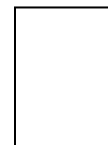

Parish Building Usage: The Archdiocese of Louisville requires that all events held on parish property that are not a parish sponsored event, be required to have an insurance policy to cover said event. This insurance policy can be purchased for \$95.00 through the Archdiocese and provides \$1,000,000.00 in coverage. This insurance must be applied for at least 15 days prior to your event. If you do not wish to use this coverage, then you must present a rider provided by your own insurance company stating you have \$1,000,000.00 coverage or \$500,000.00 of coverage (alcohol excluded) to cover said event. This insurance coverage is in addition to the rental and deposit fees.
